Referral to Oncology Coordinator

Users Impacted by the Change: Clinicians caring for oncology patients

Providers have a referral order to oncology coordinators. Oncology coordinators will receive this order and help facilitate both the admission and discharge of patient on chemotherapy.

Using order entry you can type referral to oncology coordinator and the follow order will display
